- hiking
- horseback riding in Ayat-sur-Sioule
- canooing in the scenic gorge of the Sioule River
- mountain biking
- flyfishing on the Sioule River
- swimming in the nearby lakes of Saint-Gervais,
 Saint-Eloy-les-Mines, Servant, méandres de Queuille
 and Sioule River
- relaxing in the thermal baths of Châteauneuf-les-Bains
- exploring the medieval castles of Chouvigny and Château-Rocher
- visiting the paleontological museum in Menat

Day excursions

- visiting Clermont-Ferrand and the newly opened Michelin museum (59 km)

- learning about seismic and volcanic activity in Vulcania adventure park (51 km)
- visiting one or more of the 80 volcanoes of the Chaîne des Puys (40 km)
- hiking and swimming in the Gour de Tazenat, a volcanic crater lake (25 km)
- discovering the history of the Volvic water spring in Volvic
- exploring the plateau de Gergovie where Julius Caesar's army was defeated in 52 BCE by the Arverni tribes led by Vercingétorix
- visiting the Musée de la Coutellerie in the town of Thiers known for its centuries old production of cutlery
- Le Pal attraction park and zoo (91 km)
